

Accommodation regulations

1. Night rest in the pension is valid from 22:00 - 7:00. The guest is obliged to observe good manners in the pension, maintain order and respect the rights of other guests.
2. When the guest leaves his room, closes all water taps and turns off the lights, turns off all appliances (TV, etc.), closes all windows and locks the room.
3. It is not allowed to use your own electrical appliances in the room or in the corridors of the pension, except for appliances used for personal hygiene of the guest (razors, hair dryers, massage devices, etc.), telephones, laptops, tablets and chargers for these devices.
4. The guest is not entitled to move the furniture in the room without the consent of the accommodation provider.
5. Smoking and lighting a fire is forbidden in the whole pension without exceptions.
6. Accommodation of animals in the pension is not allowed.
7. If defects occur, the guest notifies the accommodation provider, who will eliminate these defects as soon as possible (according to their nature). The guest does not rectify any defects by his own means.
8. Accommodated guests are obliged to comply with fire, safety, hygiene and environmental regulations, instructions for the use of electrical appliances, plumbing and electrical equipment.
9. It is forbidden to bring flammables and chemicals, including narcotics and explosives, into the premises of the pension.
10. It is forbidden for persons who are not accommodated to enter the pension (except the reception).
11. The accommodated guest is not entitled to allow entry to Pension Dagmar to any persons, without exception.

12. The guest uses the equipment of the rooms only for the purposes for which this equipment is intended and is fully liable for damage caused intentionally or negligently. The person accompanying them during the stay is fully responsible for damages caused by children and minors. In case of damage, the landlord has the right to ask the guest to pay the damage on the spot in cash. The landlord provides a written confirmation of the damage paid.

13. The landlord does not bear any responsibility for damage to the guest's property, or theft of things left in freely accessible parts of the pension. The property of the accommodated guests is not insured by the landlord.

14. The landlord has taken all measures to prevent damage to the health of the guests and is not responsible for their health during normal operation. The health and life of the guests are not insured by the landlord.

15. The landlord is not responsible for jewelry, money and other valuables of the guest. The landlord does not store valuables.

16. Bicycles and scooters can be left in the designated room by guests by prior arrangement and in cooperation with the landlord.

17. It is forbidden to hang any objects, especially clothes and shoes, on the windows.

18. Payment for the stay is non-refundable. In case of an early departure, the guest is not entitled to a refund of the stay or part thereof.

19. If the guest does not properly register for the stay on the day of arrival at the agreed time, the reservation of the entire stay is considered canceled by him without the right to a refund and the guest is not entitled to draw any part of this booked stay.

20. In case of violation of these accommodation rules, the guest's stay is terminated with immediate effect by the landlord, without the right to return the unused part of the payment for the booked stay.
